



PREVENTING DISASTER TO TROOP TRAINS. When a troop (or other important train) is travelling through the enemy's country, great precaution is taken to guard against it being blown up or destroyed in some way. The method shown in our sketch is used. Two trucks, heavily loaded with worthless materials, are placed in from of the engine and act as a "dummy head." Should a mine or explosive, be placed on the line, the trucks come into contact with it before the engine, and bear the brunt of the damage.

PENETRATION OF BULLETS. When a defensive work of any kind is being made, it is necessary to remember that some substances offer more resistance than others. Neglect of this fact may lead to disaster, for instance, to throw up a breastwork of wood less than four feet thick would be useless, for that thickness of wood is the least that will stop a bullet. Brickwork must be nine inches to be proof, and earthwork at least three feet thick.
